3.2 Accommodation

Our institution supports international students /staff in finding accommodation, according to the requirements of the ERASMUS Charter for Higher Education. It offers allocated places in student residences and informs about offerings in private accommodation, as there are not enough places in student residences available.

3.3 Living Costs

Monthly 800 – 900 EUR (for housing, meals, books, trips etc). In addition appr. 320 EUR semester contribution to be paid before enrolment. This contribution includes a ticket for free public transport in the city and area of Bielefeld and on regional trains/buses in North-Rhine Westphalia for the whole semester, i.e. six months.

3.4 Visa

Our institution will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outgoing students/staff, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education. Information and assistance can be provided by our incoming coordinator and advisor for international students.

3.5 Insurance
